

Gulf CHMA Update – Aug 2012, Cycle 19

As of the 19th cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has decreased from 5,010 to 4,969 with 994 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 20% not surveyed). In the 5 county area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed increased from 821 to 822, and 220 MB had n/a for their data (27% not surveyed). The 19th cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 31 August 2012. All county ACP counts are decreasing. The map now shows only Cycles 10 – 19 to better fit the data (Fig. 1). There are now only 5 hotspots (i.e. Multi-block ID with ≥ 21 psyllids)(woohoo!) for Cycles 17, 18, and 19 (see interactive map for locations).
