

# Gulf CHMA Update – Dec 2012, Cycle 23

As of the 23<sup>rd</sup> cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has increased from 5149 to 5153 with 699 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 14% total not surveyed). In the 5 County area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed increased from 807 to 814 and 98 MB had n/a for their data (12% not surveyed). For comparison, total MBs surveyed in the other CHMAs combined totaled 4,339 MB with 601 n/a for 14% not surveyed (just about even with the Gulf CHMA this cycle). The 23<sup>rd</sup> cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 23 November 2012. All multi-blocks have remained flat although Charlotte County is showing an increase in ACP. The map now shows only Cycles 16 – 23 to better fit the data (Fig. 1). There remains **only one** hotspot (i.e. Multi-block ID with  $\geq 21$  psyllids) for Cycles 21, 22, and 23 (see interactive map for locations).
