

# Gulf CHMA Update – Feb 2012

As of the ninth cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has increased from 5,917 to 5944 with 855 in the 5 county area. The ninth cycle of the statewide survey was completed 3 Feb 2012. Glades County has had a rise in average psyllid counts since Cycle 8, whereas all remaining Counties have had a sharp decrease with Collier and Lee Counties having virtually no psyllids present (Fig. 1).
