

Gulf CHMA Update – Nov 2012, Cycle 22

As of the 22nd cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has increased from 5073 to 5149 with 558 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 11% total not surveyed). In the 5 County area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed increased from 806 to 807, and 186 MB had n/a for their data (23% not surveyed). For comparison, total MBs surveyed in the other CHMAs combined totaled 4,342 MB with 372 n/a for only 9% not surveyed. The 22nd cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 2 November 2012. All multi-blocks have remained flat. The map now shows only Cycles 14 – 22 to better fit the data (Fig. 1). There is now **only one** hotspot (i.e. Multi-block ID with ≥ 21 psyllids) for Cycles 20, 21, and 22 (see interactive map for locations).
