

Gulf CHMA Update – May 2013, Cycle 30

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As of the 30th cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has increased from 5225 to 5439 with 721 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 13% total not surveyed). In the 5 County area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed stayed the same at 813 with 108 MB had n/a for their data (10% not surveyed). For comparison, total MBs surveyed in the other CHMAs combined totaled 4,405MB with 448 n/a for 13% not surveyed. The 30th cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 19 April 2013. All Counties but Glades increased substantially in ACP densities. The map now shows only Cycles 23 – 30 to better fit the data (Fig. 1). The number of hotspots has increased from 3 to 9 (i.e. Multi-block ID with ≥ 21 psyllids) for Cycles 28, 29, and 30 (see interactive map on our website for locations of psyllid counts and hotspots).
