Vision for the Future: New Center Director Dr. Kelly Morgan began as SWFREC's leader on August 1, but has been a faculty member at the center since 2004. He recently penned a vision statement for the future of the research center, including: "The SWFREC conducts high-priority research and extension functions to generate new technologies and improved practices used by growers of the state to solve problems related to agricultural production and protection of natural resources. General goals of SWFREC include alternative citrus and vegetable crop production practices, insect and mite management, plant disease diagnostics and control, and improved irrigation and nutrient management. Specific technologies researched by SWFREC include precision agriculture technology, computer-aided irrigation scheduling, growth model based nutrient management, organic options, soil microbiology, plant physiology, water conservation, and principles of economics and labor supervisory techniques. Future needs of SWFREC include improved drainage on our experimental fields and grove, an upgraded irrigation system to commercial production standards, new farm equipment to improve our production practices, and a new residence dorm to house our growing number of masters and Ph.D. graduate students."
