

Gulf CHMA Update – June 2012, Cycle 15

As of the 15th cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has decreased from 5,804 to 5,072 with 1,317 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 26% not surveyed). In the 5 county area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed decreased from 879 to 868, and 221 MB had n/a for their data (75% surveyed). The 15th cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 8 June 2012. All counties are on the increase in ACP counts with a substantial escalation of ACP in Lee County (Fig. 1). Glades County appears to be leveling off. There are now 9 hotspots (i.e. Multi-block ID with ≥ 21 psyllids) for Cycles 13, 14, and 15 (see interactive map for locations).
