## **Gulf CHMA Update – Sept 2012, Cycle 20**

As of the  $19^{th}$  cycle, the total number of MB surveyed has increased from 4,969 to 5,178 with 776 of these having n/a (i.e. not available – 15% not surveyed). In the 5 County area, the number of multi-blocks surveyed increased from 822 to 829, and 256 MB had n/a for their data (30% not surveyed). The  $20^{th}$  cycle of the statewide survey was completed on 21 September 2012. Collier and Lee County ACP counts are increasing. The map now shows only Cycles 11 - 20 to better fit the data (Fig. 1). There are now 10 hotspots (i.e. Multi-block ID with  $\geq 21$  psyllids) for Cycles 18, 19, and 20 (see interactive map for locations).
