"Individual Protective Covers (IPCs) and Brassinosteroids" by SWFREC citrus horticulturist Dr. Fernando Alferez. This seminar will feature the latest information on the combined use of IPCs and Brassinosteroids in two scenarios: First, the use of Brassinosteroids to prolong tree health after IPC removal under HLB conditions; second, the combined use of IPCs and Brassinosteroids to recover HLB-infected young citrus trees, giving these trees a second chance to become productive. 1 CEU each for pesticide license renewal and certified crop advisors.
